Regional Overview						
As of 2 March 2026, there has been no internationally recognised legal closure of the Strait of Hormuz, but Iranian radio warnings, heightened military risk, and company level directives have led to a sharp reduction in commercial traffic, with most vessels temporarily avoiding transit despite a small number continuing to pass through.						
Airspace is closed in most Gulf countries.

Terminals, marine services, cargo handling, and gate operations are functioning without disruption. There are no operational changes for today. Royal Jordanian issued an updated advisory - flights arriving from the EU, US, North Africa, Saudi Arabia, and Lebanon are operating as scheduled, with only minor delays possible due to regional developments. Flights to Syria, Iraq, the UAE, Bahrain, Kuwait, and Qatar are temporarily suspended after those countries closed their airspace. RJ confirms that Sunday, March 1 flights remain largely unaffected to most destinations. Passengers are advised to check their flight status on RJ's official website before heading to the airport.
